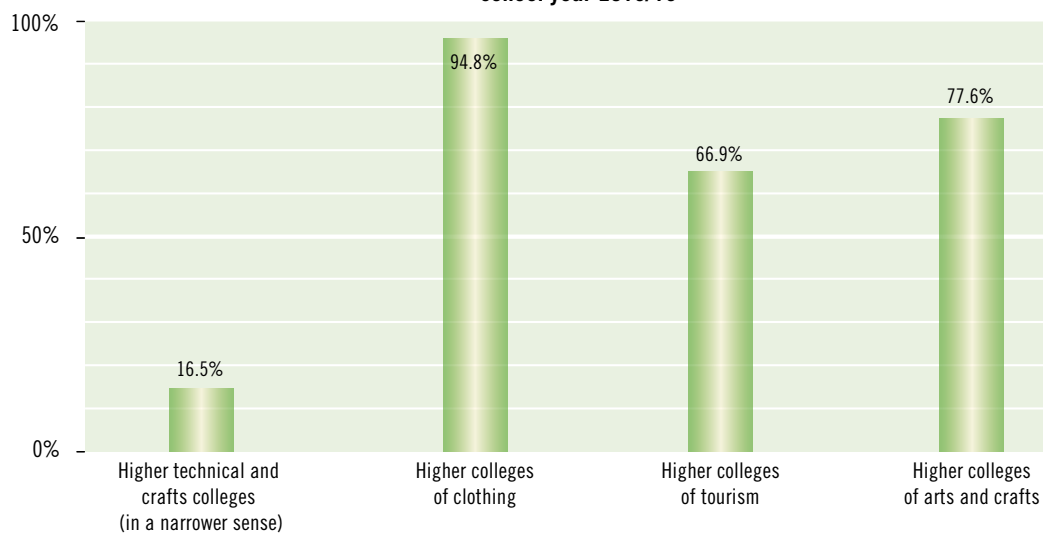

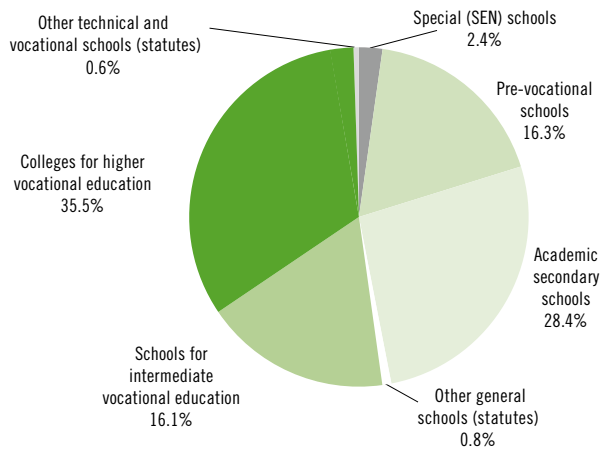

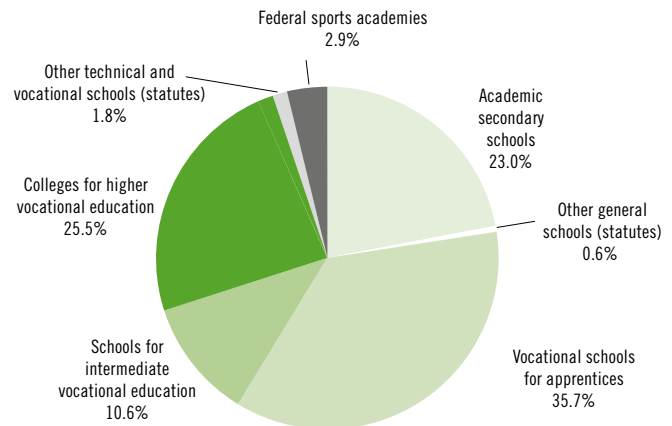
Proportion of school types at grade 5

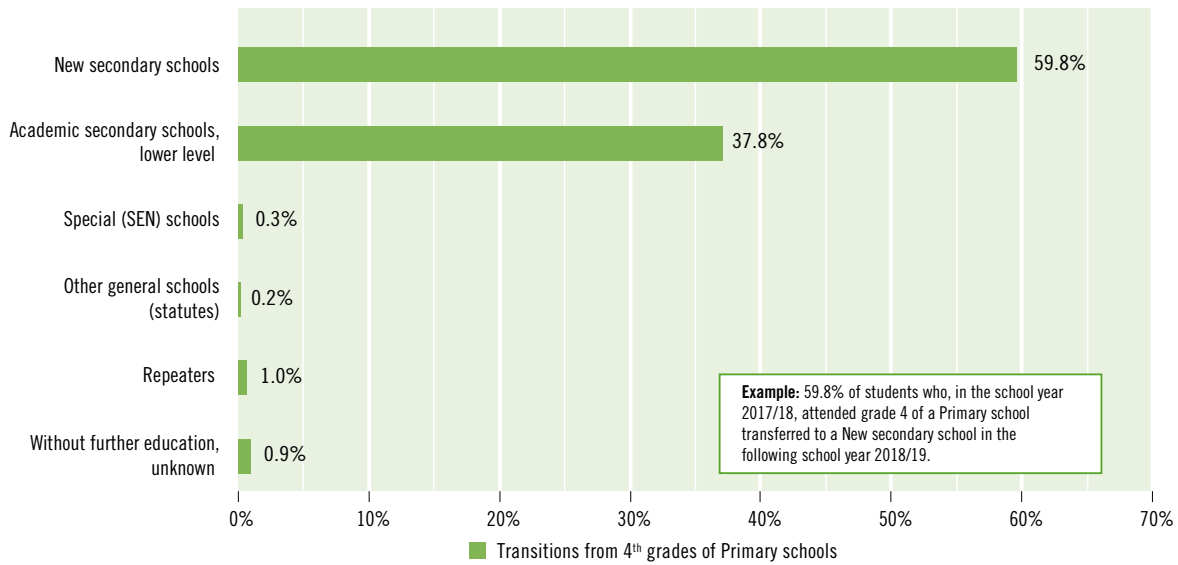

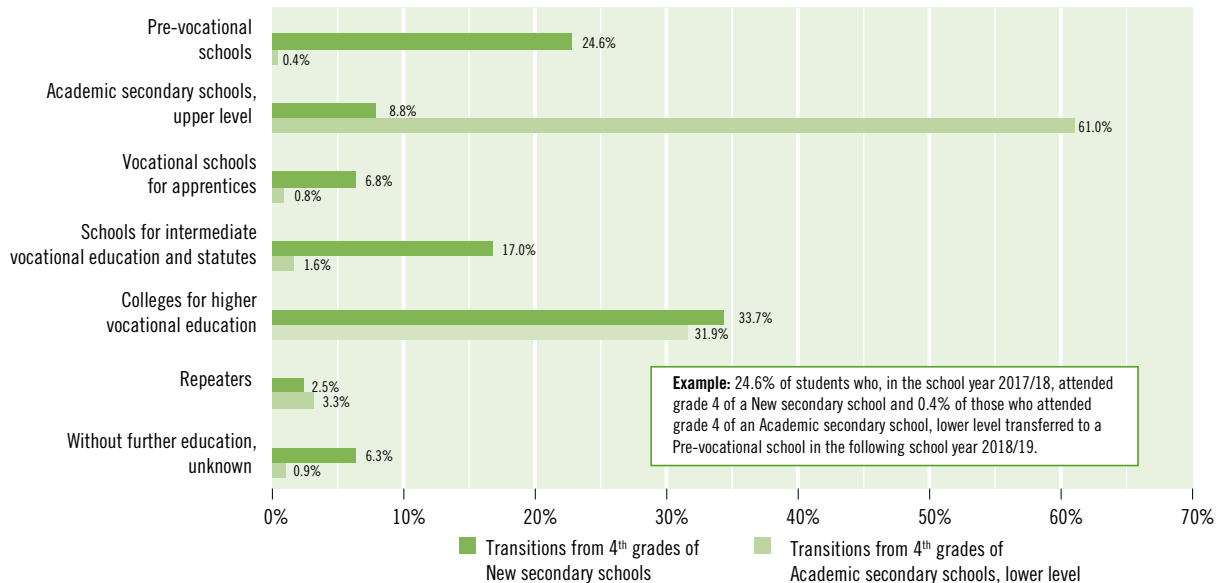
